# Napa County households impacted by the **LNU Lightning Complex Fire** and/or the **Glass Fire**

## **Economic Hardship**

- Household income at or below 120% of Area Median Income (i.e. \$120,500 for household of 4)
- Lost wages or employment due to the fire
- Not eligible for disaster unemployment insurance
- Undocumented residents encouraged to apply
- County residents can receive a one-time payment of \$1,500

## **Lost or damaged property**

- Household income at or below 150% of Area Median Income (i.e. \$150,600 for household of 4)
- Primary residence was damaged or destroyed (red tag or yellow tag)
- Renters can receive up to \$3,500 as a one-time payment
- Homeowners can receive up to \$7,500 as a one-time payment
